Aeromexico Announces Nonstop Service to Guadalajara from Silicon Valley's Airport

Six-Weekly Flights to Begin July 1, 2017;
SJC Grows to 15 Airlines: Nine Serving Nonstop International Destinations –

SAN JOSE, CA, Feb. 21, 2017 – Mineta San José International Airport's (SJC) airline and passenger growth continues with <u>Aeromexico's</u> announcement today of nonstop service between San José and Guadalajara (GDL) to begin July 1, 2017. Aeromexico will operate six-weekly flights to GDL on Boeing 737-700/800 aircraft. Visit www.aeromexico.com for bookings and information.

"San José adds up as our 6th destination in California in which our client flow will arrive directly from Guadalajara, one of the airline's main HUBs", said Anko van der Werff, Aeromexico's Chief Revenue Officer. "This new route will bring more connectivity options between Mexico and the United States with more than 2,200 weekly seats for our clients traveling for business or pleasure."

Guadalajara, Mexico's second largest city and its high-tech center, was founded in 1542 and has grown to a large and modern city contrasted by 17th century churches and light rail. It is a hub for business and is also a top destination for Silicon Valley travelers returning to visit family and friends. Located in the State of Jalisco, Guadalajara is also a sister city for San José.

"San José shares deep economic, educational, and cultural ties with Mexico, and we are proud to welcome Aeromexico and their new nonstop service to Guadalajara," said San José Mayor Sam Liccardo. "This new flight is an important investment in San José's sister city relationship with Guadalajara. It will foster business-to-business connections for Silicon Valley companies, and provide another convenient flight option for business travelers and those visiting family and friends in both of our cities."
